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HOW IT WORKS

Five blocks. Roughly 9 to 4, with a working lunch.

01 • MORNING Discover Your goals and their drivers: cost, risk, contract or lease exits, AI readiness. The current estate surfaces — data centers, AWS or GCP, VMware, apps, databases and data, plus dependencies and hidden costs.	02 • LATE MORNING Rationalize Each workload gets a disposition: lift and shift to VMs or Azure VMware Solution, containerize on AKS, or move to PaaS such as App Service and Azure SQL. New apps and data are shaped cloud-first. The first wave emerges.	03 • EARLY AFTERNOON Design Your Azure architecture — a new landing zone, or your existing one enhanced: subscription hierarchy, hub-and-spoke or Virtual WAN network, ExpressRoute or VPN connectivity, and where each system lands.	04 • MID AFTERNOON Govern The controls the platform must meet from day one: Entra ID and RBAC, Azure Policy, Defender for Cloud, availability zones with Backup and Site Recovery for HA / BC / DR, Azure Monitor, and cost guardrails.	05 • LATE AFTERNOON Act Waves sequenced, the roadmap agreed in the room with owners named, costs and Microsoft funding lined up, and the next step — an Azure Migrate assessment or Migration Hub Accelerator — booked.
